## Mr Stone's Guide to Google's 3D Augmented Reality (AR) Animals

## You will need:

- 1) An AR capable device, such as a smartphone.
- 2) An internet connection.
- 3) Room for a giant panda or great white shark (you can shrink them to fit your space, though!)



## How to explore a 3D animal:

1) Load the Chrome browser app



- 2) Search for one of these animals (discovered so far there may be more):
  - Alligator
  - Angler fish
  - Brown bear
  - <u>Cat</u>
  - Cheetah
  - <u>Dog</u>
  - <u>Duck</u><u>Eagle</u>
  - Emperor penguin
  - Goat
  - <u>Hedgehog</u>
  - <u>Horse</u>
  - Lion
  - Macaw
  - Octopus
  - <u>Pug</u>
  - Giant panda
  - Rottweiler
  - Shark
  - Shetland pony
  - Snake
  - <u>Tiger</u>
  - Turtle
  - Wolf
- 3) Scroll down or you may need to click **images** first and find the **View in 3D** panel. This will only appear if your device is AR capable.



4) Scan the surroundings to create a surface for the animal. When ready, it will appear. Explore in 3D by moving your phone as you walk around the animal.
